Broker's Courses Offered

Jack Waller, President of NCI Associates, is offering the Associate Broker/Broker License Training classes at NOCBOR, beginning **Tuesday**, **March 6**.

Currently, broker license applicants need 90 hours of certified education and 3 years relevant related experience (typically measured by a minimum of 6 transactions in each of the 3 years). By offering the 30 hour-RES 201 course first, students will be prepared to take the actual state exam and complete the other two courses without having to worry about exam preparation issues.

The broker classes are all Michigan specific and help students obtain the highest "designation" awarded by the State of Michigan, that of Associate Broker. Students will be trained on strategic risk management issues and help raise the level of professionalism within their existing office.

The fee for each of the three courses is \$325, which includes an extensive textbook and materials package for each course. (NOCBOR offers members an interest-free education loan for all three classes. No interest is charged and the loan must be repaid within one year.)

Course Descriptions:

Broker License Prep (RES 201)-This "flagship" course provides the information you need to successfully complete your Michigan Real Estate Broker's License exam. There are no gimmicks or unnecessary materials to fill time. The class concentrates on solid information, successful testing techniques, developing good preparation habits and confidence building. (Tuesdays, March 6, 13, 20 & 27)

Policy & Procedure Manual (RES 203)-This program is the only one of its type to actually help you create or upgrade the most important tool in your risk management arsenal. Realcomp Amends Policies

The Realcomp Board of Governors recently implemented the following policy:

"If a Listing Broker/Agent, seller or Web site is charging a mandatory fee to be imposed upon the purchaser of a property, notice of that mandatory fee must be included in the Public Remarks section of the listing. Any negotiable fees must be included as an addendum and uploaded as a document attachment on the listingin Realcomp Online®. Violation of the policy will subject the listing agent to a fine of \$500." purpose of expanding the policy is to ensure that both mandatory and negotiable fees that are being charged by the listing Broker/Agent, seller or Web site to purchasers are fully disclosed to buyer's agents (and their buyers) regarding the listing.

Appraisers Continuing Education

On Friday, February 17, 2012, REALTOR/Appraiser Brian Kirksey will offer "2012-2013 7 Hour National USPAP Update" and "2 Hours of Michigan License Law," which is intended for real estate appraisers, brokers and sales agents, for the cost of \$165.

The program is approved for **7 hours of continuing education credits for USPAP**, and **2 hours of Michigan License Law** through the State of Michigan for real estate appraisers and real estate agents. The USPAP class is also AQB approved for 2011-2012 and is required continuing education for appraisers renewing every 2 years. Materials for the class must be preordered.

To attend, you must make your reservation no later than **February 6, 2012**. Registration begins a 7:30 a.m. **Class begins at 8 a.m. and will conclude at 6 p.m.** Interested in attending, contact 248-674-4080.

It's Never Too Early!

2012 is the year that your real estate license must be renewed. The three-year cycle also mandates that to renew your license for an additional three years, you must have completed eighteen (18) hours of continuing education, including six (6) hours of real estate law. NOCBOR will offer its first 2012 6 hours of continuing education on Friday, March 30, 2012, 9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. All Committee **members** may attend the 2012 continuing education training at NOCBOR, free of **charge**, for their participation. The author of the course, Jack Miedema, will instruct the class, which includes the mandated 2 hours of real estate law. The 6 hours of training is \$35 and you can register for the class by calling 248-674-4080.
